Funding Research and Development:

has accelerated the increase of funding!



Policy making:

> encouraging!



Political Patronage and Scientific Enquiry:

highly encouraging



Institutional Development:

>highly encouraging



Gender Equality:

> encouraging



Educational Reforms and Higher Education-Scientific Production Nexus (Shift of Colleges to Universities):

accelerating



Knowledge Production:

partially severe restriction and at the same time increasing the knowledge production.



International Collaboration:

>mildly affected.



Regional Collaboration:

very diverse effect. Mostly increased



Science, Innovation and Islam:

increasing effect on rethinking of how to face modernity and modern science



Local versus Global Scientific Production:

> increased the global production



Mobility and Free movement of Scientists:

more obstacles but at the same time much more effort to override it



Science in Iran, like the other Moslem countries, has been stagnating, mostly due to the miss-conception of science and identifying it with knowledge. The sanctions regime has initiated a dynamic to start a phase transition to learn how the process of modern science is working within a society.
